DRI Rubber attaches great value to the protection of your personal data. In this privacy policy we want to provide clear and transparent information about how we handle personal data. By personal data we mean all information concerning an identified or identifiable natural person.

Why we process personal information?

Your personal information is processed by DRI Rubber for the following purposes:

- To conclude and carry out our contracts;
- To call or e-mail you to maintain good commercial relations;
- To inform you about changes in our services and products;
- To offer you our services and products;
- For the handling of your complaint;
- To process your job application.

For the purposes as mentioned, we may request the following personal information from you:

- name and address details, phonenumber, e-mail, education and work experiences.

Provision to third parties

We may provide the information that you give to us to third parties, if this is necessary for the execution of the above described purposes. This could include an IT supplier. We never pass on personal data to other parties with whom we have not entered into a processor agreement. With these parties (processors), we make the necessary arrangements to ensure the security of your personal data.

Furthermore, we will not provide the information you provide to other parties unless this is legally required and permitted. We may also share personal data with third parties if you give us written permission.

With due observance of the foregoing, it is possible that we provide personal data to parties which are located outside the EU. With due regard for the above provisions there is the possibility that we provide personal data to parties which are located outside the EU. You can think of our offices in USA and Russia.

If the countries to which your personal data are transferred do not offer an equivalent level of protection for personal data to the laws of the Netherlands, we will ensure that appropriate precautionary measures are taken.

We will use one of these protections:

- We transfer it to a non-EEA country with privacy laws that offer the same protection as the EEA. Read more on the website of the European Commission.
- We set up a contract with the recipient, which means that they have to protect your personal data according to the same standards as the EEA.
- We transfer it to organizations that are part of Privacy Shield. This is a framework that sets privacy standards for data that is transmitted between the US and EU countries. It ensures that these standards are comparable with what is used within the EEA.

Retention period

DRI Rubber stores personal data no longer than necessary for the purpose for which it was provided or required by law.

Protection

We have taken appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect your personal data against unlawful processing, taking into account the state of the art.

The following measures have been taken:

- Automatic updates of system software and antivirus program;

Rights concerning your data
